 Fill the dish with an appropriate amount of wax, do not overfill the dish. If using a fragrance oil, use 2 to 3 drops of oil diluted with water.

 Place one unscented tealight candle at the bottom of the burner and ensure the
- wick is standing. Light the candle with a long handled lighter.
